Assuming we have cold weather this winter, displaced people may, by that time, have a place to stay, but may not be warm, or warm enough.

Second, for any displaced families, the parents may have no money for Christmas. So, we'd also like to help in that area of anticipated need.

All warm items and gifts will be taken to Bay St. Louis, Mississippi, the week before Christmas, and the distribution effort will be coordinated by our chapter with a local church in Bay St. Louis.

It appears that the age group that will be the hardest to accommodate are teenage boys and girls, so that will probably be the biggest need. The preferred guidelines for the kids Christmas gifts are as follows:

Purchased (or in excellent condition)

Leave Unwrapped

No electronics

Include batteries if required

Smaller in size

Attach tag to gift indicating sex and age of child

Price: no more than \$15-20
